Expanding Capacity. Strengthening Communities.

Communities across the region are actively pursuing grants—but limited staff time, technical expertise, and resources can make the process challenging.

NRPC's Grant Writing Assistance Program helps municipalities identify funding opportunities, strengthen grant applications, and build local grant-writing capacity.

Why The Program Matters

A regional survey found that many communities:

- Apply for grants frequently
- Lack time or grant writing expertise
- Want to pursue more funding opportunities

Top barriers identified by communities

- Limited staff time
- Grant writing experience
- Matching fund requirements
- Identifying grant opportunities
- Complex application processes

Our program was created to help communities overcome these challenges.



Tiered Support Model

Tier 1 – Universal Services (Free)

Grant opportunity alerts, resources, and workshops.

Tier 2 – Enhanced Assistance (Hourly or Task Based Fee)

Application review, technical support, and specialized mapping.

Tier 3 – Full-Service Grant Writing (Hourly or Task Based Fee)

Complete application development for local or regional projects.

- Strengthen local grant-writing capacity
- Support regional collaboration
